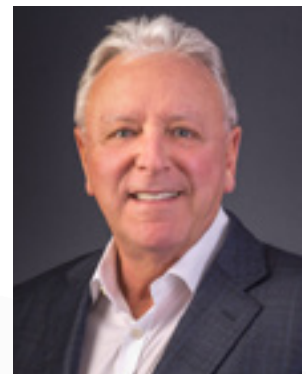

Studies estimate that 1 in 36 children in the United States are diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). In 2005, the same year Judson Center established its Autism Connections Program, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services described the increasing number of individuals diagnosed with ASD as an "urgent concern". For 18 years, we have served and partnered with families and shared in their joy as their children, teens and young adults have begun to blossom as their full neurodivergent selves. Today, Judson Center's Autism Connections Program has grown and evolved to offer comprehensive services that foster acceptance and empowers families and children diagnosed with ASD to grow and thrive!

Michigan is facing a decline in primary care physicians that is specifically impacting underserved communities. To compound this health challenge, the aftereffects of the global pandemic on the mental health of children, teens, and adults is still being measured. In 2022, the number of people looking online for mental health support increased 500%. Between the decline in access to primary care and the increased demand for mental health and substance use disorder support, our efforts are more important than ever. In response to this great need and motivated by a belief in whole-person care, we opened Judson Center Family Health, a combined initiative with MedNetOne Health Solutions. The clinic offers both primary care and behavioral health care in one location, truly setting us apart from other providers. Our Primary Care professionals partner with our

therapists, and substance use disorder team to help individuals prioritize their physical and mental health. Since being designated as a Certified Community Behavioral Health Center (CCBHC) in 2020, Judson Center continues to offer easy access to help our clients improve their health and build resilience for the future.

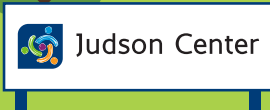

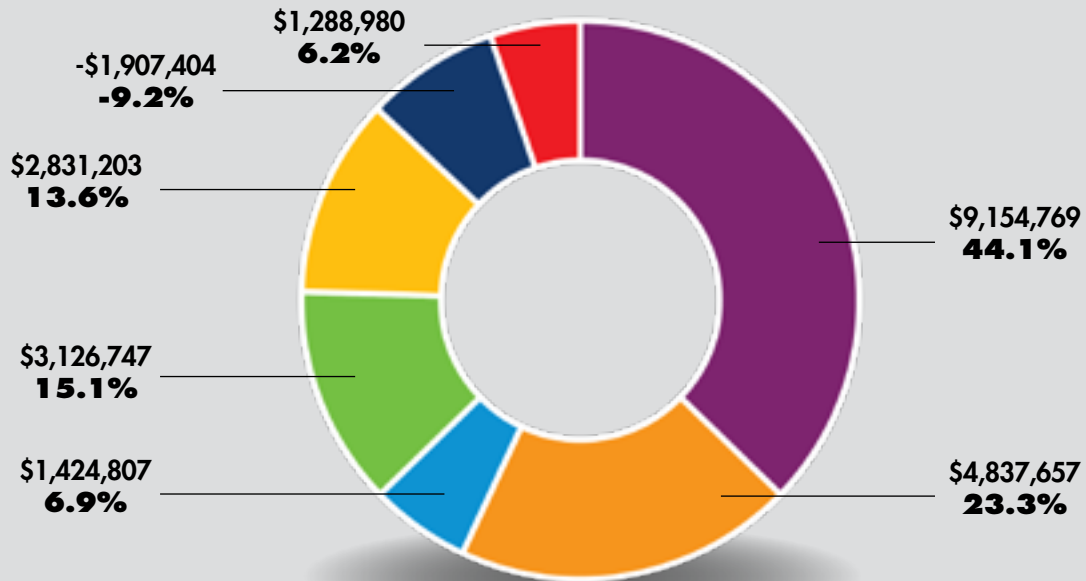

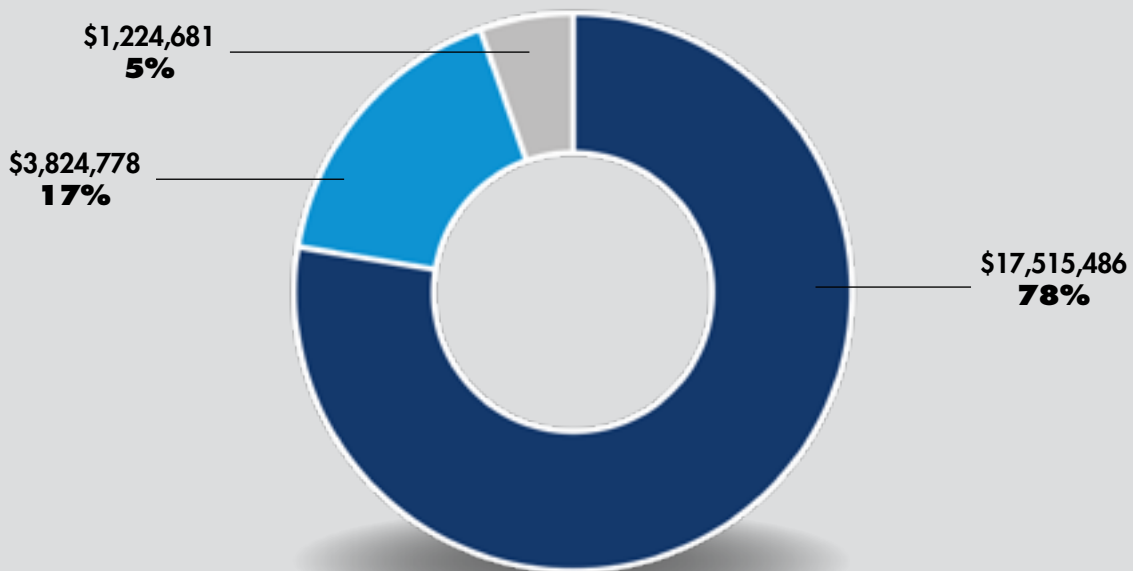
