First Home Visit Checklist for Prospective Foster Parents

This list is not all encompassing; it is a general guide to help get you started

Overall Maintenance		
	Entire home is clean, safe, in good repair	
Heat, Light & Ventilation		
	Heat & lights are working	
	Screens on all doors & windows if used for ventilation	
	Furnace & water heater are working and regularly maintained/inspected	
	Fireplace has safety screen	
	Bedrooms can NOT have portable heating equipment	
<u>Detectors</u>		
	At least 1 smoke detector located on each floor, including basement, and between	
	sleeping areas & the rest of home	
	Carbon monoxide detector installed as per manufacturer's recommendation	
	All detectors are installed properly & in working order	
Water Supply		
	Water comes from approved source	
	Toilets: at least one in working order	
	Washbasin/sink: at least one in working order	
	Water temperature does not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit	
	Sewage disposal is through public system or approved manner	
<u>Bedrooms</u>		
	Allow for both rest & privacy	
	40 square feet of floor space per person	
	Contain space for storage of clothing and personal belongings (closet, dresser, etc.)	
	Finished ceiling, permanently affixed walls, & finished flooring	
	Contain at least 1 window that is accessible, readily opened from inside the room, and	
	can be used as an exit by all children & caregivers

Bedrooms cont.

	Have a latch-able door that leads directly to means of egress
	Children over 3 years old cannot routinely sleep in a parent's bedroom
	Children over 5 years old cannot share a room with the opposite sex
	Each child must sleep alone in a bed sufficient to meet their needs
	No inflatable mattresses
	Mattresses must be on a bedframe unless individual requested otherwise
<u>Haza</u>	rdous Materials
	Guns: unloaded and properly stored in locked metal or solid wood gun safe, OR trigger locked and stored in locked area. Ammunition must always be stored in a separate locked location.
	All cleaning supplies, tools, and other dangerous items are stored securely and inaccessible to children
	Medications, including over the counter nonprescription drugs, must be kept in a locked location.
<u>Pets</u>	
	All animals must be safe to be around children
	Must be vaccinated and licensed in accordance with the laws of the city
<u>Othe</u>	<u>r</u>
	Exits: each floor has 2 exits (includes basement if used as living space)
	Telephone: operating telephone is available in the home at all times
	Emergency numbers are within sight of the home phone
	Child safe covers on outlets, child gates, and child-proof locks on cabinets based on age of children
	Car seats as appropriate for age of children
	All cribs must have fixed sides
	Rescue equipment must be placed near pools & other bodies of water
П	Exterior doors leading to pools & other hodies of water must have an alarm
